- 12-103. Demolition of structures; disconnection of sewers. In addition to the requirements of the International Building Code, as amended, requiring permits for demolition of structures, the city shall have the authority to disconnect the lines from that property upon which a building is being demolished and cap off the tap into the city's sewer main unless at the time of the issuance of the demolition permit the owner represents that he intends to rebuild upon the same premises and secures a building permit. Provided, however, in that event the owner must furnish satisfactory evidence that the lines on his property are in good repair and free from dirt, debris, or other material that would cause blockage and that the same is free from holes or any other condition that would allow surface water or any foreign matter to be introduced into the sewer system.
