- **20-101.** <u>Definition</u>. Tree surgeon: shall include any person, firm corporation or partnership, whether as owner, agent or partner who is professionally engaged for hire in the business of trimming, cutting or removing trees within the Town of Petersburg. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)
- **20-102.** <u>Permit required</u>. No tree surgeon shall engage is such business without a permit or proper insurance. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)
- **20-103. Duration of permit**. Said permit shall not have a duration of more than one (1) year from date of issuance. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)
- **20-104.** <u>Fee for permit</u>. A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be collected for the issuance of each permit. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)
- **20-105.** <u>Application</u>. The applicant for such permit shall submit to the town recorder a written affidavit of application containing the following information:
 - (1) Name of applicant;
- (2) Complete permanent business address and, if applicable, the local business address; and
 - (3) Insurance information. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)

- **20-106.** Responsibility of tree surgeon. All tree surgeons shall be responsible for the removal of debris resulting from their activities. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)
- **20-107.** <u>Debris; penalty</u>. It shall be unlawful for any tree surgeon to leave any debris along the right-of-way of public street of the Town of Petersburg. A violation of this chapter is punishable by a penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00). Each day the debris is allowed to remain shall constitute a new and separate offense. (Ord. #2004-4, July 2004)
