#### **CHAPTER 2**

# ARREST PROCEDURES

### **SECTION**

- 6-201. When police officers to make arrests.
- 6-202. Disposition of persons arrested.
- **6-201.** When police officers to make arrests. Unless otherwise authorized or directed in this code or other applicable law, an arrest of the person shall be made by a police officer in the following cases:
- (1) Whenever he is in possession of a warrant for the arrest of the person.
- (2) Whenever an offense is committed or a breach of the peace is threatened in the officer's presence by the person.
- (3) Whenever a felony has in fact been committed and the officer has probable cause to believe the person has committed it.
- **6-202.** <u>Disposition of persons arrested</u>. A person arrested for a felony or a misdemeanor shall be disposed of in accordance with applicable federal and state law and the rules of the court which has jurisdiction over the offender.
