11-102. Child Curfew Act adopted.

11-101. <u>Posting notices, etc.</u> No person in the city shall fasten, in any way, any show-card, poster, or other advertising device upon any public or private property in the city unless legally authorized to do so. (1998 Code, § 11-701)

11-102. <u>Child Curfew Act adopted</u>. The Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Bolivar, pursuant to <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, § 39-17-1701, adopts the Child Curfew Act of 1995,² and shall become effective immediately upon adoption. (1998 Code, § 11-702)
