17-101. Refuse defined. Refuse shall mean and include garbage, rubbish, leaves, brush, and refuse as those terms are generally defined except that dead animals and fowls, body wastes, hot ashes, rocks, concrete, bricks, and similar materials are expressly excluded therefrom and shall not be stored therewith.

17-102. Throwing and dumping refuse. It shall be unlawful for any person or business or company to intentionally throw, discard or dump within the City of Rockford, Tennessee any trash, garbage, paper, cans, bottles, empty containers, refuse of any kind, or any waste-type material, upon their own property or property belonging to another in the city or on any public street, road, highway or any other public area within the city when such trash, garbage, paper, cans, bottles, empty containers, refuse of any kind, or any waste-type material, is in the public view and can be seen from a public area within the City of Rockford. 17-103. Accumulation of refuse. It shall also be unlawful for any person, business or company to intentionally allow the collection or accumulation of any trash, garbage, paper, cans, bottles, empty containers, refuse of any kind, or any waste-type material, upon their own property within the City of Rockford, Tennessee when such trash, garbage, paper, cans, bottles, empty containers, refuse of any kind, or any waste-type material, is in the public view and can be seen from a public area within the City of Rockford. Property maintenance regulations: title 13.

17-104. Violation. (1) Any person, business or company who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).

(2) After a citation is issued and served upon the party charged for violation of any provision of this chapter, each day after issuance and service that the provisions of this chapter are violated by said party shall constitute a separate offense and said party shall be guilty of an additional misdemeanor, punishable as herein provided.
