# CHAPTER 1

## **GARBAGE**

## SECTION

17-101. Dumping prohibited.17-102. Collection fee.17-103. Violation and penalty.

**17-101.** <u>Dumping prohibited</u>. It shall be unlawful for any person to dump garbage, trash or waste of any kind, on either property belonging to the Town of Kimball, or property belonging to persons other than the one dumping, or upon the right of way of any public streets, roads or alleys within the Town of Kimball, with the one exception being the property belonging to the Town of Kimball set aside for the purpose of dumping.

It shall also be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, or other agency to operate or maintain any place within the corporate limits of the Town of Kimball where garbage, trash or other waste of any kind is dumped or otherwise disposed of. (Ord. #5, April 1965, as amended by Ord. #15, April 1970)

**17-102.** <u>Collection fee</u>. (1) It is hereby established and imposed a garbage collection fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per month for two (2) days per week pick-up service for the users of the commercial garbage collection service within the Town of Kimball, Tennessee.

(2) The city recorder or assignee shall prepare statements twice yearly in January and July of each calendar year showing the total fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) due for each upcoming six (6) month term and shall mail or cause the same to be delivered to the user within ten (10) days after the beginning of each six (6) month term.

(3) Any person or user failing to pay the fee hereby established when and as the same become due, which failure continues for a period of ten (10) days from and after notice as provided in subsection (2) above, shall have the service discontinued and shall not have same restored until all past-due fees

**17-103.** <u>Violation and penalty</u>. The violation of any section, part or provision of this chapter is hereby declared to be a civil offense punishable upon conviction, by a civil penalty of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Each day's violation of any section, part or provision of this chapter shall be a separate offense. (Ord. #5, April 1965, as amended by Ord. #15, April 1970, modified)
