CHAPTER 1

STREET COMMISSIONER¹

SECTION

- 2-101. Appointment, compensation, oath and bond.
- 2-102. Duties.
- **2-101.** Appointment, compensation, oath and bond. The board of mayor and aldermen shall annually appoint and fix the compensation of a street commissioner. Before assuming his duties the street commissioner shall take an oath before the board to faithfully perform the duties of his office and shall be covered by a faithful performance bond in the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). (1989 Code, § 1-401)
- **2-102.** <u>Duties</u>. The street commissioner shall be responsible to the board of mayor and aldermen for the proper maintenance and repair of all city streets, alleys and sidewalks. He shall keep the board informed of the condition of city streets, etc.; shall make timely recommendations for street improvements; and, shall supervise city street labor. (1989 Code, § 1-402)

CHAPTER 2

PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

SECTION

- 2-201. Town to designate properties.
- 2-202. Authority to create advisory board, members, and terms.
- **2-201.** <u>Town to designate properties</u>. Designate properties located on Chestnut Street declared on tax maps to be Livingston City Park and Recreational Facilities whereas the Town of Livingston will appropriate funds in the budget for maintenance and operation of said park. (Ord. #2011-1-1, Feb. 2011 *Ch1_09-08-20*)
- **2-202.** <u>Authority to create advisory board, members, and terms.</u> The Livingston Parks and Recreation Board shall consist of five (5) persons, at least two (2) from school staff appointed by the Mayor of Livingston. Livingston Parks and Recreation member term is five (5) years, and members shall serve without pay. (Ord. #2011-1-1, Feb. 2011 *Ch1_09-08-20*)
