ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN CITY, TENNESSEE PROHIBITING HORSES ON PUBLIC TRAILS AND SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mountain City has developed a number of trails and sidewalks for use by the public, and;

WHEREAS, these trails and sidewalks are meant for use by all citizens without concern for the dangers which may be imposed by horses, and;

WHEREAS, the Town does not have the capacity to provide clean-up and maintenance of these facilities when they are used by horses:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN CITY, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to ride, walk or otherwise place a horse on any public trail or sidewalk in the Town of Mountain City.

Section 2. A violation of this ordinance may result in a citation to municipal court and a fine of up to \$50.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
