Notice of Policy

The University of Tennessee Municipal Technical Advisory Service has created this privacy statement to demonstrate the agency's commitment to privacy of personal information consistent with its duties and responsibilities as an agency of the state of Tennessee. The purpose of this statement is to inform you about the use of information gathered when you visit this website.

Information Collection

This website is administered by the University of Tennessee Municipal Technical Advisory Service (MTAS). In order to improve the usefulness of our website for our visitors, we automatically collect and maintain statistical information from our site's data log that concerns network traffic flow and volume. Information gathered regarding visitors to the website is of the following type: IP address, pages visited, and documents viewed while at our site, and from where you linked to us.
