3-102. Litigation tax.

**3-101.** Court costs. In all cases heard and determined by him, the municipal judge shall impose court costs in the amount of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00).

One dollar (\$1.00) of the court costs in each case shall be forwarded by the court clerk to the state treasurer to be used by the administrative office of the courts for training and continuing education courses for municipal court judges and municipal court clerks pursuant to <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, § 16-18-305(b). The above amount does not include the thirteen dollars seventy-five cents (\$13.75) litigation tax levied by the State of Tennessee. - **3-102.** <u>Litigation tax</u>. 1. On cases in city court there is hereby levied a city litigation tax to match the state litigation tax of thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 2. The privilege taxes levied pursuant to this section shall be paid to the town recorder monthly to be used to assist in paying for the operation of city court and for the police department. (Ord. #08-002, April 2008)
