- 17-103. Removal by city.
- 17-101. <u>Accumulation prohibited</u>. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to permit garbage, rubbish, waste, and other refuse materials and substances to accumulate on their premises, or in the public streets and alleys in said city, so as to create a nuisance or menace to the health of the citizens of said city. (Ord. #27, Oct. 1973)
- 17-102. <u>Refuse collection fees</u>. Refuse collection fees shall be at such rates as are from time to time set by the board of mayor and aldermen by ordinance or resolution.
- **17-103.** <u>Removal by city</u>. The city shall hereafter pickup and remove all garbage and waste materials under the following conditions:
- (1) All such garbage, tin cans, waste paper, and other waste materials can be and is placed in a regulation size garbage can with tight fitting lids.
- (2) Cans may be metal or plastic and must not exceed thirty (30) gallons.
