## CHAPTER 1

## RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

#### **SECTION**

- **2-101.** Created. The New Tazewell Recreation Advisory Board (herein referred to as the "board") is hereby created and shall be organized and operated as follows. (1998 Code, § 2-101)
- **2-102.** Powers and duties. It shall be the duty of the board to study all matters relating to the development, maintenance and use of recreation facilities and make recommendations to the New Tazewell Board of Mayor and Aldermen regarding such matters in accordance with <u>Tennessee Code</u> Annotated, § 11-24-103 (b) (1). (1998 Code, § 2-102)
- **2-103.** <u>Membership and compensation</u>. The board shall consist of five (5) persons to be appointed by the mayor and to serve for terms of one (1) calendar year. Two (2) of the five (5) recreation board appointments are to be members of the board of mayor and aldermen. Vacancies in such board shall be filled only for the unexpired terms and such appointment shall be made by the mayor. There shall be no compensation for service on the board. (1998 Code, § 2-103, modified)
- **2-104.** Organizations and meetings. The board shall elect from its appointed members a chairman, a vice-chairman and a secretary. The terms of office shall be for one (1) year. The board shall meet in regular session on a quarterly basis. Meetings may also be called by the board chairman as the need arises. (1998 Code, § 2-104, modified)
