

Female officers must adhere to the following standards:

1. All hairstyles must be neatly and evenly trimmed at all times while on duty.
2. While on duty hair must be worn in a style to maximize officer safety.

Jewelry, Sunglasses:

1. Visible jewelry is limited to two rings, watch, and medical alert bracelet. Jewelry will not be worn if it is likely to place the wearer or any other person at risk of harm. A small pair of stud earrings may be worn in ear lobes by female police officers.
2. Sunglasses can be worn by Police Officers while driving but they must be removed before speaking to members of the public.
3. Prescription glasses with transition lenses are the exception to the removal of sunglasses.

Ornamented Teeth, and Contact Lenses:

1. Teeth, whether natural, capped, or veneer will not be ornamented with designs, jewels, initials, etc.
2. Contact lenses, if worn on duty, shall be in a natural eye color.

Tattoos, Brands, Piercing, and Mutilation:

1. Intentional body mutilation, piercing, branding or intentional scaring is prohibited.
2. Tattoos, brands, piercing, (other than piercing of ear lobe as defined above) and other body art may not be visible while an officer is on-duty, and while off-duty immediately before or after shift while still on City property.
