A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SAFETY POLICY FOR THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF LYNCHBURG/MOORE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, State and Federal laws require cities and counties in Tennessee to develop policies and programs to ensure that employees work in a safe environment; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of Metropolitan Lynchburg/Moore County to provide a safe and healthful workplace free from recognized hazards which may cause serious injury to employees; and

WHEREAS, it is also the policy of Metropolitan Lynchburg/Moore County to require its employees to comply with basic safety responsibilities associated with work assignments; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Council of Lynchburg/Moore County, Tennessee that the Safety Policy shown as Attachment AA@ is hereby adopted and made a part of this resolution by reference, as if it were entered herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Safety Policy replaces any previous safety policy insofar as any conflict with its provisions may be concerned.
