AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PITTMAN CENTER ESTABLISHING PURCHASING LIMITS.
WHEREAS, <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u> Title 6, Chapter 56, Section 306, the Municipal Purchasing Act of 1983, as amended by Chapter 270 of the Public Acts of 1991, provides that advertisement and competitive bidding practices are required for all purchases in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) unless otherwise specified by ordinance;
WHEREAS, the Pittman Center Municipal Code, Chapter 4, Sections 5-401 and 5-402 establishes a purchasing limit of \$4,000;
WHEREAS, the Town of Pittman Center would like to raise the purchasing limit in order to more efficiently operate the Town's government;
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF PITTMAN CENTER, as follows:
The \$4,000 amount set forth in the Pittman Center Municipal Code, Chapter 4, Sections 5-401 and 5-402 is hereby changed to \$10,000.
