

MTAS Review of City Codes Regulation of Maximum Number of Dogs

City	Maximum Number of Animals Allowed	Comments
Athens	3	More may be maintained with a permit
Bristol	4	Combination of dogs and cats over 6 months of age; more may be maintained if used for breeding for sale to the public
Collierville	3	Dogs over 3 months of age; except for licensed dog kennels in non-residential districts
Knoxville	4	Combination of dogs and cats over 6 months of age; except for licensed kennel, boarding facility, pet shop or dealership
Nashville	5	Allows up to 5 "companion" animals provided they are provided proper care. Companion animals are domesticated animals that a reasonable person would consider to be a pet such as a dog, cat, rabbit, guinea pig, bird, amphibian, and others.
Tullahoma	6	< 1.5 acres, combination of dogs and cats over 4 months of age
	10	> 1.5 acres, combination of dogs and cats over 4 months of age
