**Ordinance No. 906, § 16-218. Facility relocation.** A rights-of-way occupant shall, within three (3) months from the date of notification, at its own expense, permanently relocate, protect, or modify any part of its facility when required by the City by reason of traffic safety, public safety, road construction, change of street grade, installation of water, stormwater, or sanitary pipes, traffic signal devices, or any other types of City improvement projects. The city manager may recommend such actions in order to prevent interference by the rights-of-way occupant's facilities with: a present or future City use of the City's rights-of-way; or a capital improvement project funded and scheduled to be undertaken by the City; or an economic development project in which the City has an interest or investment. The city manager may also recommend such actions: when the public health, safety and welfare require it; or when necessary to prevent interference with the safety and convenience of ordinary travel over the rights-of-way, both vehicular and pedestrian; or when aboveground equipment is located in such a manner as to create an obstruction to a driver's line of sight. The rights-of-way occupant may for due cause make application to the Public Works Director for an extension to complete such relocation as required by this section.
